

Peer Recovery Coaching in Hospital Settings

Peer Recovery Professionals in healthcare settings work to improve healthcare outcomes by facilitating healthcare access; adding value to the healthcare team; and enriching the quality of life for people who are experiencing substance use disorder from diverse communities.

Essential skills are a combination of people skills, social skills, communication skills, character traits, attitudes, career attributes, social intelligence and emotional intelligence that allow Peer Recovery Specialists to navigate their environment, work well with others, and achieve their goals with peers, while applying the core competencies of peer recovery practice.

This course lays the foundation of supervision in a peer support environment and incorporates Daniels' (2014) Pillars of Peer Support Supervision, Kadushin's (1976) Social Work model of the Functions of Supervision, and Bloom (1997), Anda and Felliti's (1998) work on Trauma.
