I am proud to share that Serenity Recovery Connection, Colorado's only CAPRSS-accredited Recovery Community Organization, has met the opportunities and challenges of 2025 with resilience, innovation, and an unwavering commitment to the communities we serve.

Over the past year, we have continued to strengthen and expand our programs in meaningful ways. Our Cañon City office is now fully staffed and operating full-time, serving as a vital hub for rural outreach across Fremont, Park, Chaffee, and Custer counties. Our youth and family program has grown substantially, providing support to at-risk youth in several communities throughout Southern Colorado. Through our Training and Workforce Development, we have also partnered with Jordan Peer Recovery to offer a Peer Apprenticeship Program, broadening the reach and impact of peer support beyond the traditional boundaries of the recovery field.

Serenity Recovery Connection has also made significant progress in advancing our primary mission as a Recovery Community Center by more fully utilizing our Colorado Springs office space. In addition to the services and support already offered onsite, we are pleased to have established in-office partnerships with cross-disciplinary service providers in the area. Our commitment to reducing stigma and advancing education has been further strengthened through our new Community Conversations. These forums create valuable opportunities for learning, dialogue, and connection among human service providers and the broader public.

As we look ahead, we do so with deep gratitude, clear purpose, and great hope. Every connection made, every barrier reduced, and every life touched strengthens continued support of our partners, peers, families, and community members. Serenity Recovery Connection will continue expanding pathways to healing, belonging, and lasting recovery across Colorado.

THEMES FROM FOLLOW-UP CALL DOCUMENTATION



Strong overall recovery progress and stability. Most participants report doing well or very well in their recovery, with many celebrating significant milestones (e.g., 18 months, 2+ years) and maintaining employment, housing, or legal stability.



Peer support and coaching are highly valued. Participants consistently describe coaching relationships as helpful, supportive, and relatable, often crediting peer coaches and lived experience as key factors in their recovery success.



Connections to community resources and recovery networks matter. Many participants were successfully connected to resources (housing, employment, healthcare, mutual-aid groups like SMART, Wellbriety, Recovery Dharma), which contributed to improved outcomes and ongoing engagement.



Strong word-of-mouth and opportunities to strengthen consistency. The vast majority of participants actively recommend SRC to others, reflecting high satisfaction and trust; feedback also highlights opportunities to further enhance consistency and engagement for an even stronger participant experience.

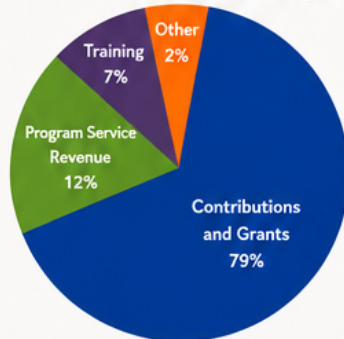
